ADVOCATE

MAS clinical staff routinely takes part in opportunities to 'talk shop'. In 2025 talks took place in area private medical practices, hospital-based clinics, sobriety support centers, integrative medical programs and various area support groups.

MAS acupuncturists performed **17,000+** treatments in 2025 including ~ **1700** at no cost as part of the Health Crisis Program.
